




FABIEN COUSTEAU

AQUANAUT, EXPLORER, DOCUMENTARY FILMMAKER

Third-generation aquanaut Fabien Cousteau, 49, is a man with a mission: to draw attention to the ocean world. In 2014, he spent 31 days underwater and broadcast the experience live. Now he's opened the Fabien Cousteau Ocean Learning Center, which focuses on education, awareness and special projects—one of which is to use 3-D printing to restore coral reefs. Once printed, the reefs will be planted in different locations in the Caribbean, where the hope is that they'll thrive and attract sea life. Says Cousteau, "We need to stop living on this planet and start living with this planet." — **LISA NIVER**
